DETERMINATION OF THE REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

AUDITOR GENERAL, ELECTORAL COMMISSIONER, DEPUTY ELECTORAL COMMISSIONER, HEALTH AND COMMUNITY SERVICES COMPLAINTS COMMISSIONER

1. SCOPE OF DETERMINATION

- 1.1 The Remuneration Tribunal is given jurisdiction pursuant to Section 14 of the *Remuneration Act 1990* ("the Act"), to determine the remuneration payable to the Auditor-General, Electoral Commissioner, Deputy Electoral Commissioner, and Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner.
- 1.2 The Tribunal determines that the salaries payable to the statutory office holders referred to above shall be as follows.

2. SALARY

2.1 Auditor-General

The salary of the office of Auditor-General shall be \$311,571 per annum.

2.2 Electoral Commissioner

The salary of the office of Electoral Commissioner shall be \$195,218 per annum. This salary will increase to \$227,000 per annum upon the appointment of a new Electoral Commissioner of South Australia.

2.3 Deputy Electoral Commissioner

The salary of the office of Deputy Electoral Commissioner be \$141,977 per annum, except when acting as Electoral Commissioner for a continuous period of more than one week, in which case the Deputy Electoral Commissioner will be paid for the acting period at the rate of the salary for the Electoral Commissioner.

2.4 Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner

The salary of the office of Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner shall be \$229,609 per annum.

3. TRAVELLING AND ACCOMMODATION ALLOWANCES

The allowances will be paid in accordance with the Tribunal's most recent Determination on these allowances as amended from time to time.

4. COMMUNICATION ALLOWANCE

The allowance will be paid in accordance with the Tribunal's most recent Determination on this allowance as amended from time to time.

5. CONVEYANCE ALLOWANCE

The allowance will be paid in accordance with the Tribunal's most recent Determination on this allowance as amended from time to time.

6. DATE OF OPERATION

The salaries prescribed in paragraph 2 of this Determination are operative on and from 1 July 2015, with the exception of the salary applicable to a new Electoral Commissioner of South Australia, for which the operative date is the date of appointment.
