DETERMINATION OF THE REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL
REMUNERATION OF MAGISTRATES

SCOPE OF DETERMINATION

1. The Remuneration Tribunal ("the Tribunal") has jurisdiction under section 13 of the *Remuneration Act 1990* ("the Act"), to determine the remuneration payable to Judges, Magistrates and holders of the public offices listed in that section of the Act.
2. This Determination sets out the remuneration payable to Magistrates.

SALARY

3. Annual salaries for the following Magistrates will be as follows:

	per annum operative 1 November 2018
Chief Magistrate*	\$380,800
Supervising Magistrates	\$346,160
Assistant Supervising Magistrate of the Adelaide Magistrates Court	\$339,240
Magistrates	\$322,710
Magistrate appointed Warden under the <i>Mining Act 1971</i> as amended and performing the duties of Senior Warden paid the salary shown for as long as that person continues to perform such duties.	\$340,040

*A judicial officer who is appointed to the office of the Chief Magistrate whose primary office is a Judge of the District Court is entitled to the salary of a District Court Judge, as prescribed by section 6A of the *Magistrates Act 1983* and section 6 of the *Judicial Administration (Auxiliary Appointments and Powers) Act 1988*.

ALLOWANCES

4. Annual allowances for the following Magistrates will be as follows, and will be payable in addition to any entitlement to salary under this Determination:

	per annum operative 1 November 2018
Magistrate appointed to the position of Supervising Regional Manager by the Chief Magistrate with the concurrence of the Attorney-General, to perform special duties as specified by the Chief Magistrate, and associated with the role of Supervising Regional Manager, for as long as that person continues in that position and performs the duties of that position.	\$31,660
Magistrate directed by the Chief Magistrate with the concurrence of the Attorney-General to perform special administrative duties in a region (Regional Manager) or in a residential country area (Country Resident Magistrate) paid the allowance shown for as long as that person continues to perform such duties.	\$23,460
Magistrate appointed to the position of Manager Family Violence List by the Chief Magistrate with the concurrence of the Attorney-General, to perform special duties, relating to family violence state-wide, for as long as that person continues in that position and performs the duties of the position.	\$23,460
Magistrate directed by the Chief Magistrate with the concurrence of the Attorney-General to perform special administrative duties at a particular court (Magistrate-in-Charge) paid the allowance shown for as long as that person continues to perform such duties.	\$9,130
